Background

New facilities were required to accommodate new scanners funded through the DOH Cancer Plan Initiative and New Opportunities Fund. The Trust aims to achieve the lowest waiting times for scans in the UK.

Features

A two-storey building with a pitched roof and brick slip cladding. It incorporates RF enclosure, magnetic and lead shielding protection and has concrete bases to bear the weight of the scanners.
